

Does the A.L.L. for Kids Program accept donations?

The “A.L.L. (Activity, Leisure, Lessons) For Kids” program covers the cost of extra-curricular activities for children whose parents could otherwise not afford it. The program has financially supported the activities of approximately 1,000 children per year since its inception in 2001.

The Municipality of Chatham-Kent covers operating costs for the program (ie. one Program Co-ordinator, computer costs, etc). Funding for the activities is received via the Social Assistance Restructuring Reinvestment Funding, through Canadian Tire Jumpstart funds, as well as through various donations. Parents are screened for financial need prior to the children receiving assistance. Unfortunately, the need always outweighs the money available.

An official donation letter would also be issued. 100% of donations to A.L.L. for Kids go directly to the kids activities – administration costs are NEVER deducted from donations.
