



## NOTICE OF MOTION

I, Councillor Brian King hereby provide Notice of Motion to Chatham-Kent Council.

Motion      **Re: Active Transportation**

For the health of its citizens, Chatham-Kent needs more active transportation.

The priority in active transportation should be the items which will benefit the most citizens on a daily basis with minimal costs.

I would therefore make a motion to direct staff to review the safe route to school plan, and return with:

- a report to Council making recommendations on priorities for safe routes to school,
- suggest a policy which would assist with the installation of the necessary sidewalks and
- make recommendations on sources of funding for the program.

Chatham-Kent currently has as a lifecycle category called, "Community Trails", which has a balance of \$228,000 and an annual contribution of \$196,000. It is planned to increase this annual contribution up to \$830,000 annually.

In order to promote active transportation, the report should address how the trails and active transportation can work together to best serve the health of our community.
