PURPOSE AND EFFECT – The Municipality of Chatham-Kent is proposing to amend building permit fees pursuant to Section 7 (6) of the Building Code Act. The effect will be to increase the existing fee structure and introduce a new fee. Information will be provided at the meeting on the estimated costs of enforcing and administering the Building Code Act, the amount of the proposed fees and the rationale for changing fees.

ANY PERSON may attend the public meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition to the proposed fees.
