**as a result of the work associated with**

### **Contract T10-187: Lord Selkirk Bridge over Sydenham River Trunnion Girder and A-Frame Rehabilitation**

Please take note that, due to planned bridge rehabilitation work, navigational restrictions will be imposed at the Lord Selkirk Bridge on McNaughton Avenue over the Sydenham River. Planned construction at the Lord Selkirk Bridge will require the bascule spans of this bridge to be fixed in place. These spans will not be lifted under any circumstances to marine traffic requiring clearance in excess of 10'-0" (3.0 metres) beneath the bridge. Marine traffic which is capable of passing beneath the fixed spans of the structure are invited to do so subject to directional signage posted along the waterway.

The restrictions outlined above will be in place effective:

**DATE:** Monday, August 16, 2010 (after WAMBO)

**TIME:** 7:00AM

The restrictions identified above will remain in place for the remainder of the navigational season and will be lifted in early December of 2010. Owners and operators of marine vessels are requested to plan their access to the Sydenham River accordingly and in observance of the above restrictions.
