LittleCounters is a community-based, free workshop that introduces the importance of early math learning and helps to build mathematical skills.

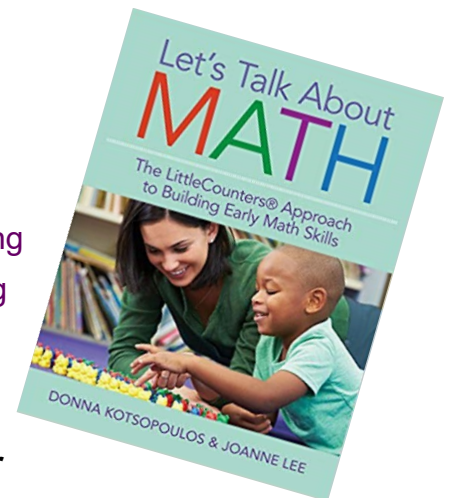
Mathematical concepts are modelled and introduced through purposeful play using toys, games, songs, stories, and poems.
