

Terms of Reference

Committee of Revision for Local Improvements,
Municipal Act 2001 - O. Reg. 586/06 as amended

Representation:

A committee of three or five members appointed by Council. Each member will be qualified to be elected to council and whom a majority of its members constitutes a quorum. A new member may be added to the committee when a vacancy occurs on the committee.

Mandate:

The court or revision presides to hear objections prior to a special charge being imposed by the treasurer of the municipality.

Notification of Hearing:

The municipality shall set a time and a place for the court of revision and give notice of the hearing to the public and to the owner of every lot to be specially charged.

Power of the Court:

- a) To review and correct the local improvement roll as to the following matters
- The cost of the work.
 - The names of the owners of the lots.
 - The frontage or other measurements of the lots.
 - The amount of the reduction or increase to be made under section 16 or 17 in respect of any lot.
 - The lots that would be exempt from being specially charged, but for subsection 12 (7).
 - The lifetime of the work.
 - The charge per meter of frontage to be imposed on any lot.
 - If all or part of the owners' share of the cost is to be specially charged on lots that do not abut on the work,
 - i. the non-abutting lots that are to be specially charged, and
 - ii the amount of the special charge to be imposed on them.
- b) Add a lot to be specially charged
- c) Special charge imposed if circumstance change
- d) Reduce special charge in case of gross error

Limitations:

The committee or revision cannot change proportion of municipality's and owners share of cost except as provided for in the Act.

Amendments:

The treasurer of the municipality shall make any corrections to the local improvement roll that are necessary given effect to a decision of the committee of revision and shall certify the corrected roll.
