Subject: Multi-Residential Building Permit Fee's

Recommendation

1. The Municipality of Chatham-Kent set a maximum amount of \$20,000.00 per permit fee for residential buildings containing up to 20 dwelling units.

2. The User Fee By-law 19-2020 be amended to add an additional residential line to include a maximum permit fee amount of \$20,000.00 for residential buildings containing up to 20 dwelling units.

Background

At the council meeting of February 10, 2020, Councilor Thompson brought forth the following Notice of Motion:

"That a cap fee schedule be developed for small scale multi-residential units and that report brought to Council no later than August."

Comments

At the February 10, 2020 Council meeting, Municipal Council approved a maximum amount of \$50,000.00 per building for residential building permit fees.

During deliberation, Councilor Thompson's request asked that staff look at a cap for small scale multi-residential development.

Similar to large multi-residential development Chatham-Kent has only recently seen the development of small multi-residential developments.

In keeping with the strategic planning session held on January 12, 2020, Building Development Services suggest that similar to the \$50,000.00 cap for new residential

buildings, a maximum limit on building permit fees per multi-residential buildings containing up to 20 dwelling units.

The User Fee By-law (Appendix A) will require the following amendments:

The Community Development Leadership Team has reviewed the proposal and is in support of the building permit fee change.

Financial Implications

A 20 unit multi-residential development has construction value of approximately \$5,000,000.00 dollars. Based on our current fee structure, the building permit fee would be \$84,500.00.

Should the Municipality receive a building permit application for a multi-residential development which includes 3 buildings, each with 20 residential units, the permit fee would be \$20,000.00 for each building totaling \$60,000.00 for the building permit fee. In such a scenario the loss of revenue will be absorbed within Building Development Services base budget.

A By-law to amend By-Law Number 19-2020, A By-law to Establish Certain User Fees

Finally passed the 15th day of June 2020.

Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent did enact By-law 19-2020 for the purpose of establishing certain user fees in the Municipality of Chatham-Kent.

And Whereas the Corporation of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent now deems it expedient to amend certain provisions contained in Schedule "A" of said By-law 19-2020.

Now Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent enacts as follows:

1. Schedule "A" 2020 Comprehensive User Fee/Deposits Review the following fees be and the same are hereby added:
