Stream 1		Plastic Bottles, Jugs and Lids	Rinse all containers. Only plastic bottles, jugs and lids with the #1through #7 symbol are acceptable.	Do not include children's toys, plastic bags, flower pots, film plastics, styrofoam and unmarked containers.
		Food & Beverage Cans/Aluminum Containers & Foil	Please rinse. All aluminium and steel food and beverage cans, pie plates, aluminum trays/baking pans and aluminum foil are recyclable.	Do not include aerosol cans, paint cans, batteries, disposable cooking tins, aluminium pie plates and other cans that once contained products classified hazardous waste.
		Empty Aerosol and Paint Cans	Please ensure the paint cans and aerosol cans are completely empty, paint is dry and lids are removed.	Paint or aerosol cans that still contain paint
		Glass Bottles & Jars	All glass bottles and jars are accepted, including coloured glass. It's not necessary to remove labels. Please rinse, remove and recycle metal lids.	Do not include medication bottles, light bulbs, window glass, mirror glass, drinking glasses or ceramics (plates, mugs, etc.)
Stream 2		Paper Beverage Cartons	Includes milk and juice cartons, drink boxes (exclude plastic straws) and Tetra Pak cartons. Please rinse cartons, remove plastic caps and flatten.	Do not include foil pouches (i.e. Koolaid Jammers), aluminum foil lined containers (i.e. wine), etc.
		Fibres - Newspaper, Magazines & Boxboard	Includes flyers, magazines, telephone books, junk mail, office paper, paperback books, hardcover books (only if hard cover is removed) and envelopes (including window envelopes), shredded paper, etc. Boxboard is defined as cereal boxes, egg cartons, pasta boxes, paper towel cores, shoe boxes, etc. Smaller light-weight boxboard must be flattened .	Do not include waxed or foil coated paper, styrofoam, or the covers of hardcover books. Note: Shredded paper will only be accepted if it is in untied clear or transparent bags.
		Corrugated Cardboard - Cardboard Boxes, Pizza Boxes etc.	All flattened cardboard not exceeding the recycling bin dimensions.	Material that is not flattened and/or exceeds the dimensions of the bin will not be accepted. All users are responsible for breaking down their cardboard before arriving at the site.
