


Caregivers Policy

<p>Who can be a caregiver?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Caregivers must be at least 18 years of age. • A maximum of 2 caregivers may be designated per resident at a time. The designation must be made in writing. • Examples of caregivers include family members who provide meaningful connection, a privately hired caregiver, paid companions and translators. 	<p>Where the home is <u>not</u> in an outbreak</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the resident is not self-isolating or symptomatic. • If the resident is self-isolating or symptomatic, a maximum of 1 caregiver per resident may visit at a time. 14 day isolation (check on additional wording).
<p>Screening</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must pass screening questions. • Verbally attest to the home that they have tested negative for COVID-19 within the previous two weeks and not subsequently tested positive. • Prior to visiting any resident for the first time after this policy is released, the home will provide training to caregivers that addresses how to safely provide direct care, including putting on and taking off required PPE, and hand hygiene. • Prior to visiting any resident for the first time after this policy is released, and at least once every month thereafter, the home should ask caregivers to verbally attest to the home that they have read/re-read the home's visitor policy. 	<p>Where the home is <u>in</u> an outbreak</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A maximum of 1 caregiver per resident may visit at a time. • A caregiver may not visit any other resident or home for 14 days after visiting another. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Resident who is self-isolating or symptomatic; and/or • Home in an outbreak. • <p>PPE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Homes are responsible for providing surgical/procedure masks. <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>

Homes have the discretion to temporarily prohibit a visitor in response to repeated and flagrant non-adherence with the home's visitor policy. In exercising this discretion, homes should consider whether the non-adherence.
