Recommendation

It is recommended that:

1. The attached by-law to amend By-law 6-2018, a bylaw to appoint Contractual Enforcement Officers be approved.

Background and Comments

Section 224 (d), of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 2001, provides that Council ensures that administrative practices and procedures are in place to implement the decisions of council.

Section 227 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O., 2001 states:

It is the role of the officers and employees of the municipality,

- (a) to implement council's decisions and establish administrative practices and procedures to carry out council's decisions
- (b) to undertake research and provide advice to council on the policies and programs of the municipality
- (c) to carry out other duties required under this or any Act and other duties assigned by the municipality

Due to new staff administration requires an amendment to By-Law 6-2018, a bylaw to appoint Contractual Enforcement Officers. (attached)
