

Notice of Complete Application and Public Meeting to Consider an Application for Consent and Zoning By-law Amendment

Take Notice that the Municipality of Chatham-Kent has received a complete Combined application (**File D-28 HA/25/25/C**) for Consent (**File B-37/25**) and Zoning By-law Amendment (**File D-14 HA/30/25/C**) under Sections 53 and 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O.1990, c.P.13, as amended, concerning property located at 10824 & 10830 Vasik Line, in Part of Lot 18, Concession 11, Lake Erie Survey, in the Community of Harwich (South Kent).

And Take Further Notice that an application under the above file numbers will be heard by Municipal Council on the date and at the time shown below:

Purpose and Effect: The subject property is located at the southerly corner of Vasik Line and Mull Road intersection, in the Community of Harwich (Roll No. 3650 140 005 50800). The lands are approximately 31.16 ha (89.36 ac.) in area and contain two (2) single detached dwellings and five (5) outbuildings. The lands are designated Agricultural Area in the Chatham-Kent Official Plan and zoned Agricultural (A1).

The application proposes to create a new surplus dwelling lot, approximately 1.17 ha (2.89 ac.) in area, containing the two (2) existing single detached dwellings (10824 & 10820 Vasik Line) and five (5) outbuildings including barns, a shed and a silo. The retained farm parcel will be approximately 34.99 ha (86.47 ac.) in area and consists of vacant farmland and will continue to be farmed in such a manner that it is today.

Zoning By-law Amendment

To implement the proposed severance, a zoning by-law amendment is required to:

- rezone the residential surplus dwelling lot to a site-specific Agricultural-1173 (A1-1173) Zone that permits a surplus dwelling on a lot greater than 0.8 ha (1.98 ac.); and,
- rezone the retained parcel to a site-specific Agricultural-1 (A1-1) zone to prohibit future dwellings.

Any person may make written representation in support of or in opposition to the proposal.

Any Person may attend the public meeting and/or make written representation in support of or in opposition to the proposed zoning by-law amendment or consent application. Those who wish to address Council respecting this matter are requested to notify the Municipal Clerk's Office by telephone prior to the meeting.

If You Wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed zoning by-law amendment or proposed consent, you must make a written request to the **Municipal Clerk, Municipality of Chatham-Kent, at the address below.**

If a Specified Person or Public Body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of Council of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make a written submission to the Corporation of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent before the by-law is passed or consent is granted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a Specified Person or Public Body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make a written submission to the Municipal Clerk of the Corporation of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent, before the by-law is passed or consent granted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
