

Notice of Complete Application and Public Meeting to Consider an Application for Consent and Zoning By-law Amendment

Take Notice that the Municipality of Chatham-Kent has received a complete Combined application (**File D-28 OR/41/25/D**) for Consent (**File B-75/25**) and Zoning By-law Amendment (**File D-14 OR/41/25/D**) under Sections 53 and 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O.1990, c.P.13, as amended, concerning property located at Gosnell Line, Part of Lot 18, Concession North of Middle Road, in the Community of Orford (East Kent).

And Take Further Notice that an application under the above file numbers will be heard by Municipal Council on the date and at the time shown below:

Purpose and Effect: The subject property is located at the southeast corner of Kenesserie Road and Gosnell Line, with additional frontage along Mazan Line, in the Community of Orford (Roll No. 3650 260 004 19010). The property is approximately 43.7 ha (108 ac.) in area and contains vacant farmland, approximately 4.6 ha (11.5 ac.) of woodlot, and three (3) accessory structures. The woodlot feature is designated Significant Woodland by Schedule C2 – Natural Heritage & Hazard Features (Orford) in the Chatham-Kent Official Plan. The lands are designated Agricultural Area in the Chatham-Kent Official Plan and zoned Agricultural (A1).

The application proposes to sever and convey 1.2 ha (3.0 ac.) of land from the subject property as a lot addition to the abutting parcel known as 20513 Kenesserie Road (PIN: 00661-0034). The lot addition lands are comprised of a portion of the woodlot, and contain the three (3) accessory structures. The retained parcel will be approximately 42.5 ha (105 ac.) in area and will contain vacant agricultural land and the remainder of the woodlot feature.

Zoning By-law Amendment

To implement the proposed lot addition, it is recommended that the lands be rezoned as follows:

- rezone the portion of the subject lands containing the woodlot (Significant Woodland feature) to a site-specific Open Space-1514 (OS1-1514) zone that limits permitted uses to conservation and recreation.
- rezone the balance of the retained farm parcel to a site-specific Agricultural (A1-1678) zone. This zone will prohibit development within 30 m (98.4 ft.) of an Open Space (OS1) zone, which is the exiting woodlot feature.

Any person may make written representation in support of or in opposition to the proposal.

Any Person may attend the public meeting and/or make written representation in support of or in opposition to the proposed consent and/or zoning by-law amendment. Those who wish to address Council respecting this matter are requested to notify the Municipal Clerk's Office by telephone prior to the meeting.

If You Wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed zoning by-law amendment, or refusal of a request for consent and/or zoning by-law amendment, you must make a written request to the **Municipal Clerk, Municipality of Chatham-Kent, at the address below.**

If a Specified Person or Public Body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of Council of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent to the Ontario Land Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make a written submission to the Corporation of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent before the by-law is passed or provisional consent is granted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.

If a Specified Person or Public Body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make a written submission to the Municipal Clerk of the Corporation of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent, before the by-law is passed or provisional consent is granted, the person or

public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal, unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
