

Notice of Public Hearing of Application for Consent

Take notice that the Municipality of Chatham-Kent has received an application for Consent (**File B-61/24**) under Section 53 of the Planning Act, R.S.O.1990, c.P.13, as amended, concerning property located at 98 & 100 Erie Street North, in Part of Lot 9, Concession 9 (Howard), in the Community of Ridgetown, known as Roll No. 3650 240 001 26500.

And take further notice that an application under the above file number will be heard by the Committee of Adjustment on the date, and at the time and place shown below:

Purpose and effect: The subject property is located on the west side of Erie Street North, south of Mitton Line, in the Community of Ridgetown. The lands are approximately 1,184.6 sq. m (12,751 sq. ft.) in area and contain a semi-detached dwelling, currently under construction. The property is designated Employment Area in the Chatham-Kent Official Plan and zoned Residential Low Density Second (RL2).

The application proposes to divide the property along the party wall of the semi-detached dwelling to establish freehold units. The resulting parcels can be described as:

- Severed Parcel: approximately 592.3 sq. m (6,375.5 sq. ft.) in area. Parcel will contain one (1) semi-detached dwelling unit assigned municipal address 100 Erie Street North; and,
- Retained Parcel: approximately 592.3 sq. m (6,375.5 sq. ft.) in area. Parcel will contain one (1) semi-detached dwelling unit assigned municipal address 98 Erie Street North.

The Key Map on the reverse indicates the location of the lands affected by the proposed Consent application in relation to other lands within the Municipality.

Any person may attend the hearing and/or make written or verbal representation in support of or in opposition to the proposal.

If a specified person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed Consent, does not make written submissions to the Committee of Adjustment before a decision is made, the Ontario Land Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Committee of Adjustment in respect to the proposed Consent, you must make written request to the above address.
