

scholarship award 2022







The Thames Art Gallery is offering a one thousand dollar scholarship award to a Chatham-Kent secondary school student who intends to further their education in any of the visual arts including fine arts, commercial or graphic arts. The recipient must be planning to attend a post secondary institution (college or university) full-time in the fall of the year following graduation. If you are applying to any of the following programs, you are eligible to apply for the Thames Art Gallery Scholarship Award: Visual arts, fine arts, film, photography, animation, digital media, graphic design and craft.

This scholarship is graciously donated by sponsor Cathy Van Raay-Myers who made this opportunity possible for the students of Chatham-Kent.

Art Scholarship Submission Guidelines

Eligibility

Open to all Chatham-Kent students who have applied to a post-secondary institution. Eligible students must submit a portfolio of work by email to the Thames Art Gallery no later than June 28, 2022. Portfolios must include a minimum of six works to a maximum of eight works in a variety of media. The gallery strongly recommends submitting a variety of works, including drawing, painting, sculpture, printmaking, and mixed media in your portfolio presentation. Try to include both representational and abstract work. Applicants must be available for an interview with the Curator upon submission of their portfolio and application.

Submission deadline: June 28, 2022 at midnight

How to apply

Please fill out the **Art Scholarship Award Application Form** and email application form and photos of your artwork to **ckartgallery@chatham-kent.ca** with the subject line "Art Scholarship Award".

Applicants must be available for an interview with gallery upon submission of their portfolio and application. Appointments for interviews will be scheduled by Thames Art Gallery staff on June 30, 2022. Interviews will take place on July 11 and 12.

Award

Art Scholarship is sponsored by Cathy Van Raay-Myers. This scholarship of a \$1000.00 will be awarded to a graduating student attending a post-secondary program in the fall.

If you are applying to any of the following programs, but not limited to, you are eligible to apply for the Thames Art Gallery Scholarship Award: Visual arts, fine arts, film, photography, animation, digital media, graphic design and craft.

Award Recipient

The recipient of the Thames Art Gallery Scholarship Award will be announced with the opening of "Here I Am" Virtual Exhibition 2022. The Thames Art Gallery must receive confirmation of registration from a post-secondary institution by September 2022 before the funds are released.
