

CK's 15-39 year-old population grew 2.2%







- Building Youth Futures Reduce poverty by increasing graduation rates and access to employment opportunities
- Three Pillars:
 - Ignite (annual gathering and bi-monthly magazine)
 - Incubator (entrepreneurship support in a physical space)
 - Trailer (handyperson business)
- Ignite Gathering May 17 and 18 from 5-8PM
 - 2 Night Conference to discuss graduation rates
 - Discuss issues preventing graduation
 - Dedicated financial support to implement solutions
 - Asks:
 - Volunteer
 - 6-7 Facilitators throughout conference for each group (1 facilitator and 1 mentor with 15 students each)
 - 6-7 Mentors (who are aware of youth needs, provide knowledge and networking opportunities after event) E-mentoring platform
