



Re: Four Counties Health Services Grant

“Whereas 41.8 per cent of hospitals visits to Four Counties Health Services in Newbury are from Chatham-Kent residents.

Given that the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care does not fund clinical Capital equipment for hospitals.

Whereas Four Counties Health Services relies on surrounding municipalities to achieve financial support in kind to assist in the purchase of such clinical equipment.

I move that \$100,000.00 be transferred from the Strategic Development Reserve to the Community Support Reserve and that \$20,000.00 annually from 2018 to 2022 be paid from the Community Support Reserve to Four Counties Health Services Foundation to support the purchase of a new endoscopy system. Further that Legal Services draft the necessary grant agreement.
