Subject: Inshes Avenue On-Street Parking – Community of Chatham

The Engineering and Transportation Division completed a review of the existing on-street parking along Inshes Avenue in the Community of Chatham.

A 2 Hour limit is currently in place along the east side of Inshes Avenue between Harvey Street and King Street West. However, this limit is no longer needed due to the decreased parking demand in the area with the closure of the former St. Joseph's Hospital on King Street West (currently Riverview Gardens).

A parking survey was sent out to the residents along Inshes Avenue between Harvey Street and King Street West with the following parking control recommendations:

- Remove the existing "8 am-6 pm Except Sundays and holidays, 2 Hour limit" on-street parking along the east side Inshes Avenue between Harvey Street and King Street West from the Traffic and Parking By-law Number 245-2004, Schedule "F" Limited Parking Permitted.

100% of the residents who responded (9 total) to the letter were in support of the omission of the on-street parking limits. The parking control sign changes implemented on Inshes Avenue are illustrated in Figure 1. These changes were completed in September of 2017.

An amendment is required in the Traffic and Parking By-law #245-2004 in order to recognize the changes to the Inshes Avenue on-street parking. A By-law amendment (Appendix A) is included in the Council package for reading and approval.

A By-law to amend By-law Number 245-2004 of the
Municipality of Chatham-Kent.
(Limited Parking Permitted along Inshes Avenue in the
Community of Chatham)

FINALLY PASSED the _____ day of _____, 2018

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent did enact By-Law 245-2004 for the purpose of regulating traffic on highways in the Municipality of Chatham-Kent.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent now deems it expedient to amend certain provisions of said By-law 245-2004.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent enacts as follows:

1. Schedule "F" (Limited Parking Permitted) of By-law 245-2004 be and the same is hereby amended by deleting therefrom;
