August 2017 Surface Water Quality Monitoring Event – September 2017

A Letter of Notification for the scheduled August 2017 Surface Water Quality Monitoring Event was received. A summary of the findings was distributed to the Members in the Agenda package. **John Ferguson** provided a brief overview of the findings to the Committee.

Monitoring tasks including surface water quality monitoring are completed during regularly scheduled events to investigate whether the closed landfill affects the surrounding natural environment. Surface water quality testing was completed at two stations and results satisfied relevant Provincial Water Quality Objectives (PWQOs) including total phosphorous which is usually influenced by surrounding agricultural activities rather than a landfill leachate effect. Monitoring station SW-3 was dry during August 2017 and no offsite discharge occurred. No additional monitoring was recommended until the next scheduled monitoring event in the Fall of 2017.

It is expected that landfill gas monitoring results, groundwater quality, and surface water quality results during the Fall 2017 monitoring event and residential well monitoring results during November 2017 will be summarized and discussed at the next Committee meeting in March 2018.
