



## Motion

Re: **Community Beautification Service Levels**

Whereas On June 24 Councillor Harrigan's brought forth a successful motion which was approved by Council "That Administration provide a report to council identifying the current levels of service for support of beautification initiatives provided to communities for services such as flower basket hanging and holiday streetlight decorations, and that this report recommend processes, or policies (new or existing) to improve the scheduling and/or equalize the service levels across CK, along with the budget implications associated with those recommendations".

And Whereas subsequent to that motion, Council received and approved the recommendations in the report regarding Downtown Service Level Standardization on January 13, 2020.

And Whereas on May 11th council approved a resolution reducing the service level due to COVID-19.

Be it therefore resolved that Council direct staff return to the normal service levels for community beautification going forward with regards to downtown banners/decorations/flower baskets and barricade installation for special events. The beautification of our community continues to be an important part of Chatham-Kent during the Covid-19 Pandemic and that the upcoming Remembrance Day and Holiday Season which is normally supported by the Public Works Department in the form of hanging banners and/or decorations resumes to normal standards.
