Re: Drainage Plan and Master Plan Servicing Study for Shrewsbury

“Whereas resiliency, economic prosperity and open and transparent government are all key elements of CK Plan 2035;

And whereas the community of Chatham-Kent continues to promote tourism, encourage assessment growth and the creation of housing opportunities;

And whereas the community of Shrewsbury has struggled for decades without a formal community drainage plan. And whereas that lack of drainage plan is inexorably linked to inadequate road drainage and road drainage is critical to the long term sustainability of any road;

And whereas Chatham-Kent’s vision statement of, ‘a welcoming, healthy, prosperous community that is culturally rich and naturally innovative’, requires investments in assets and infrastructure.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Municipality of Chatham-Kent initiate the Drainage Act to create a formal drainage plan and that the municipality cover 100% of the associated costs.

And that a Master Plan Servicing Study be completed for the entire community to investigate storm water, sanitary and water(main) requirements to accommodate current conditions as well as potential growth considerations. Also to be included in this study would be erosion control measures for the protection of Municipal infrastructure along the shorelines.”
