Make your vote count on Monday, October 24, 2022

Eligibility

To vote in a Municipal Election you must be:

- A Canadian citizen
- At least 18 years old
- A resident, or the owner or tenant of land in the Municipality of Chatham-Kent
- The spouse of such owner or tenant
- Not prohibited from voting under the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 or otherwise by law

Voters' List

Are you on the Chatham-Kent Voters' List?

Check now at www.voterlookup.ca

Fact: Provincial and Municipal lists are different. Therefore, be sure your information is correct for our Municipality's voters' list.

If you are on the Voters' List, you will be mailed your Voter Information (VIN) Card with information about when and where to vote. Voter Information Cards will be on their way late September. If you do not receive by the end of September, be sure to call 311 to get a copy of your VIN card sent to you.

You can still vote if you do not receive a Voter Information Card. Bring identification showing both your name and current residential address (e.g. Ontario driver's licence) to be added to the Voters' List at a Polling Location. Find a list of accepted identification at www.ckelection.com.

Vote Van - New Way to Vote!

New this year, our Vote Van! This will be a van that will drive around to predetermined locations during Advance Polls. Paper ballots will only be used at these locations.

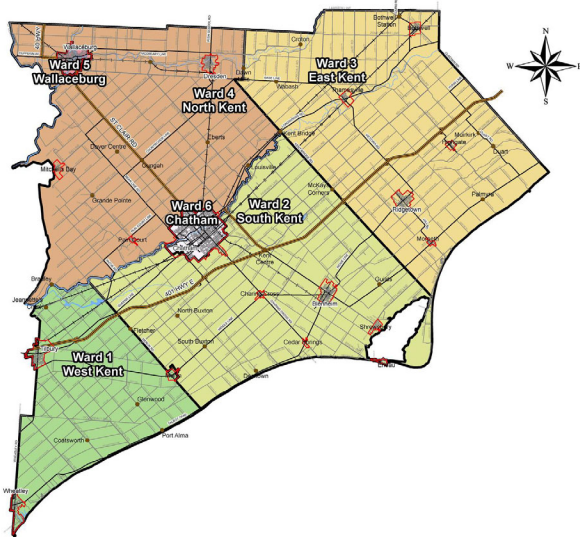
Nominations can now be filed at the Clerk's Office, Civic Centre, by appointment only. Candidates must file in person, as no electronic submissions will be accepted. The final day you can file a nomination is August 19, 2022, before 2:00 pm

Accessibility

The Clerk shall make every effort to accommodate the needs of electors and candidates with disabilities. Accessibility will continue to be monitored and accommodated. Following every Election, we are required to complete an accessibility report to Council.

During Advance Voting Days and on Election Day, an AutoMark assist terminal available to persons with disabilities to aid in the voting process will be available at a Chatham location. This unit is a paper ballot-marking technology that allows voters with disabilities and other special needs to mark their ballot privately and independently. The machine allows the voter to mark his/her ballot with the following options:

- Touch Screen, tactile buttons with Braille that can also be changed to a high contrast and has a zoom feature
- Sip/puff tube
- Rocker paddle
- Listening to the choices through headphones

Internet Voting is also available to accommodate Electors who may have accessible needs already set up at home.
