

Recycling Matters

Go Green with your blue and black box! Please keep fibre/paper material separate and in your black box. All other acceptable containers except paper beverage cartons, go in the blue box.



Recycling Box Replacements:

Replacement boxes are available **free of charge** to residential property owners having 5 or less dwelling units, at all municipal centres.

For inquiries about recycling collection call 311 or 519.360.1998 or your local Municipal Centre. The Municipality is not responsible for lost or stolen recycling boxes.

Large/Bulky Item Collection Days

The weekly limit is 1 full toter cart or 3 bags/ large items per week. DO NOT place the toter cart out in addition to a large item(s).

Tip – place out 1 or 2 regular size garbage bags of household garbage instead. Large items, provided you place out less than your weekly limit, must also be at the curb by 7am on your regular collection day to be flagged for pickup as noted below. For example: Place 1 bag out with 2 large items or 2 bags and 1 large item.



How To Use Your Toter Cart

On your waste collection day, simply place your cart against the curb or edge of pavement (not on sidewalk) and follow the instructions below.

- Place garbage in tied bags or closed boxes only
- The toter cart lid must be able to close to comply with the three (3) bag limit
- · Overloaded carts will not be emptied
- Arrow on top of lid points to the centre of the road
- Wheels are placed back against the curb or on the edge of the pavement or road
- Toter carts are placed 1 metre (3 feet) from all stationary objects including other toter carts



E-Waste and Tire Recycling

Electronic waste, used passenger/light truck tires and scrap metal are NOT collected at the curb.

- · Gasoline, oils, solvents, BBQ starter
- Aerosol cans with product
- Batteries (all types)
- E-waste Computers, TVs and electronics
- Paints, varnishes and stains
- Pool chemicals, ammonia, bleach
- Pesticides, rat poison, cleaning fluids
- Propane tanks and cylinders up to 30 pounds maximum
- Medications / Pharmaceuticals
- Fluorescent light bulbs/tubes
- Compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFL's)
- Syringes/Needles (in puncture-proof container)

Not Accepted:

- Agricultural, commercial, or industrial waste
- PCB's
- Explosives and ammunition (contact police)
- Pathogenic waste
- Radioactive waste
- Propane tanks (>30 pounds)
- Road flares
- Stay in your vehicle at all times
- Containers used to hold waste will not be returned, so please use disposable containers like cardboard boxes.
