

Waste Depot Recycling Guide

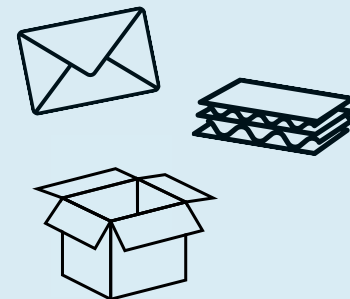
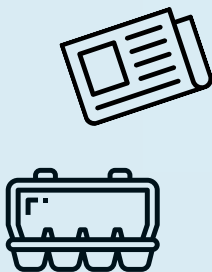
Containers

- Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Tubes, and Lids
- Food & Beverage Cans/Aluminum Containers & Foil
- Glass Bottles & Jars
- Foam Packaging
- Paper Cups & Cartons



Fibers

- Foil Pouches- Chip Bags & Snack Wrappers
- Corrugated Cardboard- Cardboard Boxes, Pizza Boxes etc.
- Newspaper, Magazines, & Boxboard
- Paper Laminate Packaging- Pet food bags, food service bags, and plates



Do

- Rinse all containers & remove plastic straws.
- Include plastic items with the #1-7 recycling symbols.
- Include all glass bottles and jars, clear and coloured.
- Include aluminum and steel food & beverage cans, aluminum trays, baking pans, and foil.
- Include Styrofoam containers & packaging.



Do

- Remove all plastic bags, inserts, or liners.
- Ensure all cardboard is flattened and fits within recycling bin dimensions.
- Make sure all items are empty and clear of any food or liquids with plastic lids removed.
- Include flyers, magazines, junk mail, office papers, paperback and hardcover books (only if hardcover is removed), shredded paper, etc.
- Boxboard items such as cereal boxes, egg cartons, paper towel cores, shoe boxes, etc., must be flattened.



Don't

- Don't include toys or other plastic items.
- Don't include K-cups (Keurig, etc.), used oil containers, and unmarked plastic.
- Don't include empty metal paint cans & cans that once contained products classified as hazardous waste.
- Don't include medication bottles, light bulbs, window & mirror glass, ceramic dishes, pots, broken glass, and needles.



Don't

- Don't include material that is not flattened and/or exceeds the dimensions of the bins
- **Users are responsible for breaking down their cardboard before arriving at the site.**
- Don't include waxed or parchment paper, or the covers of hardcover books.
- Shredded paper will only be accepted in a paper bag or an untied clear bag.
