2. The contest is not open to employees, officers, directors, or elected officials of the Municipality of Chatham-Kent, its agencies, boards, or commissions. It is not open to employees of the Chatham-Kent Barnstormers or its agencies.
3. The contest duration - the contest begins on May 15, 12:01 a.m., 2026 and ends on June 26, 11:59 p.m., 2026. All entries received through social media post or email will be considered as a ballot. A draw from all entries will be conducted on Tuesday, June 30, 2026. The winner will be announced on VisitCK Social Media accounts (Facebook and Instagram). All entries received after 11:59 p.m. on June 26, 2026, will not be eligible to participate in the contest.
4. Limit of one entry per person. Each entry is only valid if the person has liked and shared the page and post and tagged at least one other person.
5. No purchase is necessary to enter.
6. The prize consists of: A one-night stay for two people on July 11, 2026, at Retro Suites in Chatham, 2 weekend passes to the All-Star Weekend events put on by the Chatham-Kent Barnstormers, along with a variety of gift cards, as chosen by Chatham-Kent Tourism.

If an email address or telephone number is not provided, the entrant is opting out of being contacted if they are the winner and will not be contacted to obtain the prize.

10. If your entry has been selected as eligible to win a prize you will be notified by way of direct message through the platform entered on (either Facebook or Instagram). They must provide their full address along with email and phone number. Up to three (3) attempts will be made to contact the potential winner via direct messaging.
