

## Ridgetown Leaf & Yard Depot Operating Procedures

### Location:

100 Erie Street North

### Hours of Operation:

Monday-Friday 7:30am – 3:30pm

Saturday-Sunday 8:00am – 5:00pm

Closed on Statutory Holidays

### Acceptable Material:

- Leaf and yard waste restricted to brush, leaves, grass, yard clippings and ONLY logs/natural wood 30 inches or less in diameter and no greater than 5 feet in length

### Unacceptable Material:

- Clay/dirt, stumps, sod or dirt/grass mixed together, logs greater than 30 inches in diameter and 5 feet in length, food waste/other household organics, faeces, manure, straw, lumber, pressure treated wood, plywood, railroad ties, garbage and anything else which is not compostable

### Note:

- No contractors are permitted to use this site
- All residents are allowed two cubic metres (25 garbage bags) per operating day
- Christmas trees from residents only
- All users must be Chatham-Kent residents

All bags/containers, including biodegradable and paper bags, must be emptied on site. Cardboard boxes must be flattened before placing in a dumpster. All mulch and wood chips are free of charge to residents when available.

**Waste and Recycling encourages all residents in the Municipality Chatham-Kent to participate in the diversion of their leaf and yard waste.**
